

In 2021 we changed some of the language in Harvey's articles and books that addressed Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Queer people. The change that we made was to include this language in a footnote to the following articles in the following books (for books in print, we put a sticker on the first page of the article; PDFs have a footnote in the book itself):
