- Continue my own learning (e.g., Disruption, the film!, Climate newsletters, etc.)
- Inform Others
 - Master communication of key issues to non-believers with RC integrated, as possible.
 - Write my legislatures with key climate info; ask why not addressing/demand they address
 - Work to replace elected leaders creating barriers
 - Offer my neighborhood/others?: Zoom Intro To Climate Emergency webinars
- Weigh in on and find City Government Climate Plan
- Join a Climate Org dedicated to ending Fossil fuel (anyone know one?)
- Living/Housing Arrangements
 - Replace gas stove
 - Asked family about used Electric Stove (one offered to me by March 2022!)
 - Downsize house contents by 50% (Starting now)
 - Move to smaller house 3-5 yrs. (Begin researching now)
- Is there a mechanism/movement to COORDINATE actions of climate groups? (anyone?)
- Supporting PGMI
 - Native American: Explore, encourage & involve with Ganondagan (Native historic site run by Native's) climate policy
 - Native American: Correspond with Lynn at Shoalwater Bay Tribe re their climate policy (I used to work with them)
 - Supporting PGMI: National African heritage dance company: conversations with choreographer re climate change piece (I am their grantwriter)
 - Climate conversations with longtime Black friend-artist/higher education dance program director with huge Facebook following
