This *Present Time* begins with comprehensive coverage of the August 2022 World Conference. The reports show that the RC Community has moved forward decisively on several fronts. There is also good coverage of parenting, direct production workers, elders' liberation, Jewish liberation, and LGBTQ+ liberation.

For the January 2023 *Present Time*, the deadline for receiving articles and poems is November 21. For changes to the backpages lists, the deadline is November 28.
